The purpose of the Fieldwork Data Form is to facilitate communication among Fieldwork Educators, Academic programs and students. Fieldwork educators describe the characteristics of their fieldwork setting, their client population, commonly used assessments, interventions, expectations, and opportunities for students. This information is extremely valuable for students as they embark on their practicum experiences. This information is also required to meet the Accreditation Council for Occupational Therapy Education standards (ACOTE), which are to be met by all academic programs.

The Fieldwork Data Form has been developed to reflect the Occupational Therapy Practice Framework terminology and best practice in occupational therapy and to promote quality fieldwork experiences.

This document was adapted by the Florida Occupational Therapy Educational Consortium (FLOTEC) from the form originally developed by the joint effort of the Commission on Education, the Fieldwork Subsection of the Education Special Interest Section (2008), and the New England Occupational Therapy Education Council Data Form (2009).

FLOTEC adapted a companion Fieldwork Site Specific Objectives checklist to help in the clarification of expectations for the Level II fieldwork student. The checklist is organized following the AOTA Fieldwork Performance Evaluation form (FWPE) items. If your facility has its own Site Specific Objectives, just complete the Fieldwork Data Form to accompany your Site Specific Objectives document. If you prefer to use the attached UF Fieldwork Objectives then just check the first box on the form and return with your completed Fieldwork Data Form.

The Fieldwork Data Form is an important part of the collaborative process of fieldwork education. We appreciate your support and effort in providing this information to promote best practices in fieldwork education. FLOTEC's goals in providing one standard document are to simplify its content, maximize its clarity, and present it in a user-friendly format.
